3-YEAR BACHELOR'S VS 4-YEAR ELSEWHERE

In the UK:

Undergraduate degrees typically take 3 years.

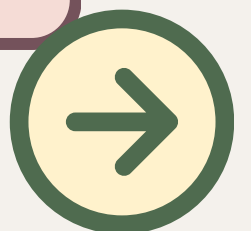
In many other countries:

4 years standard.



What that means:

- Enter the workforce earlier

1-YEAR MASTER'S = REDUCED TOTAL COST

Most UK Master's programs:

- *12 months (full-time, intensive)*

Elsewhere:

- *18–24 months*

Impact:

- Lower overall living expenses
- Faster ROI
- Less time away from workforce



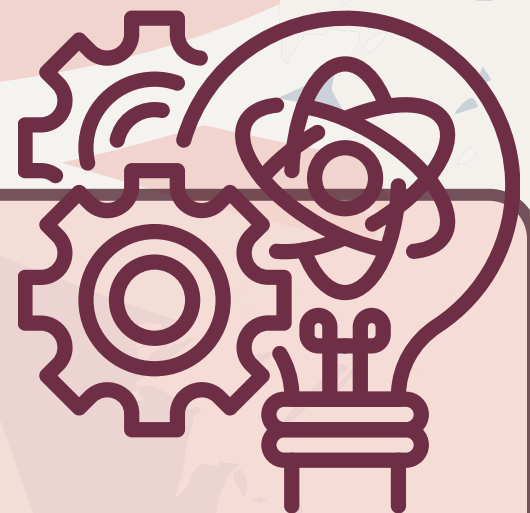
DISSERTATION & RESEARCH FOCUS

- Work autonomously

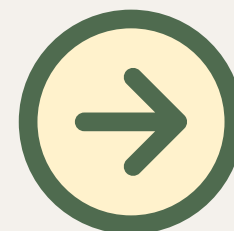


PRACTICAL + INDUSTRY- LINKED CURRICULUM
